

CNS Eligibility Evaluation for Endorsement

I. General Company Requirements
Company is legally registered in the United States and licensed to trade.
Has a physical office in the U.S.
Holds a valid Indirect Air Carrier (IAC) Certificate.
2. Operational Readiness
At least two employees at the primary location hold a current IATA DG (Dangerous Goods) certification CBTA Function 7.3 Accepting Dangerous Goods.
Can submit 12 to 15 international air waybills (AWBs) issued by the applicant, showing at least 6 months of operational activity (at least two AWBs for month for the past 6 months)
Agrees to maintain up-to-date contact and administrator information in the CNS Customer Portal.
Have access to cargo handling facilities that comply with national security standards
3. Financial Documentation Submit ONE of the following financial reports:
Compiled, Reviewed, or Audited financial report by a licensed CPA.
In-house financial report (with additional documentation and signed statements if publicly owned or disregarded LLC).
AND meet all the following conditions:
Minimum Working Capital: \$30,000
Minimum Tangible Net Worth: \$50,000
Financials closing date is within 6 months of submission.
Include Retained Earnings and Cash Flow statements.
Include a signed Accountant's Letter.
3 months of bank statements showing an average ending balance of ≥ \$15,000
Business credit report with a D&B Paydex Score of 60 or higher.



Special cases must also include (Review CNS Handbook for more details):	
Parent company's 10-Q or 10-K report (if publicly owned).	
Statement from CFO/CEO regarding accuracy and GAAP compliance (if in-house/pub	lic).
Letter from CFO/CEO explaining structure (for disregarded LLCs).	
Post-merger financials (if applicable).	
4. Security Requirements (if applicable)	
Willing to provide an Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit or Cash Deposit if minimum are not met. (\$30,000)	financial metrics
Understands that LOC will remain until metrics are met and is reviewed before renewa	ıl.
Disregarded LLCs must provide LOC regardless of metrics.	
5. CNS CASS USA Enrollment	
Will designate a CASS USA Administrator responsible for user management and billin resolution.	g/payment
